

GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF ONLINE INCA-NATIONAL MAP QUIZ 2021.

- i). **Objective** : The objective of this programme is to create awareness about maps among student Community.
- ii). **Eligibility** : The Quiz is open to the students of 8th, 9th, 10th classes.
- iii). **Centre** : its online(from your Desktop, Laptop or Mobile)
- iv). **Entry Fee** : Rs 50
- v). **Participants** : Single/ Individual.

Create an Account

1. The first step is to log on to <https://quiz.incaindia.org/quiz2021> or <https://quiz.incaindia.org> Both links will take you to the website. Click up to Register for a new membership.
2. Participant shall register for one account only. No duplicate account will be allowed.
3. Participants are required to have a valid personal E-Mail ID and valid Mobile number to complete the registration formalities.
4. A verification link will be sent to E-Mail Address to verify your E-Mail address.
5. 6-digit OTP number will be sent to Mobile number to verify your Mobile number.
6. INCA Map Quiz 2021 account will be created after submission of this form.
7. Participants will be allowed to participate in the INCA Quiz only after successful payment of Rs. 50/- (FIFTY RUPEES ONLY). Payment link will be available in participant account.
8. Participants will be needed to upload scanned or camera copy of Student ID Card or Bonafide school certificate.
9. Maximum size of uploaded ID Card (JPG format) should not be more than 640x480 pixels. Please see - how to resize photo id picture?
10. The quiz will be of 2 hour duration.
11. You can attempt the quiz only once.
12. There are a total 70 questions.
13. Each question carries one mark. No negative marking for wrong answers.
14. Questions are of Multiple Choice/Map Questions with Toposheet with answers to be typed. Mock Quiz can be attempted by the students once registration process is completed and the student is made active.

- 2 Use the details provided in the E mail sent to you with login id and password **after** you have signed up at the link and created account
- 3 If, you are not able to login, then please click **Forgot Password** and provide your E mail id/Mobile Number to get the username and password associated with the E Mail id
- 4 If you get the message **Email id doesn't exist! Then, please Sign-up.**

Attempting the quiz

1. Click the start **Map Quiz Test** button **in the website after login in.**
2. Click 'INCA NATIONAL MAP QUIZ-2021' **Quiz** under **Test Name.**
3. Click **Start Zonal Round** to attempt the quiz. For Naional Finals the link will become Final Round.
4. The time will start the moment you click the Start Test button.
5. You can resume the quiz wherever interrupted, due to any reason.
6. Click on **Next** button to move next question. **Please note that you will be able to go back to any of the previous question after clicking previous button.**
7. Click on **Submit Test** button on completion of the quiz.
8. **A Mock test is available to familiarize you with the format.**
9. We suggest that this Mock test be taken after registration and after the status is made active by the zone
